

#1145 NCAA Softball Timer

- ✓ Allows you to concentrate on your responsibilities without the distraction of checking a wrist watch

Operation



- Press the rocker switch to the "•" white dot position. Ready Ref will vibrate for two seconds at 60-seconds and vibrate again for 5 seconds at 90 seconds
- Press the rocker switch to the "o" open circle position. Ready Ref will vibrate for two seconds at 12 seconds then vibrate again for five seconds at 20 seconds
- 3. The "Reset" push button resets the timer

Maintenance

- Start each season with a new battery.
- Protect from direct heavy rain with the Rain Case provided
- When wet remove battery cover and battery then allow 24 hours to air dry

Important: Every time you reconnect the battery, press the rocker switch to "o" open circle position and allow Ready Ref to finish one complete timing cycle thru all vibration signals until the LED cycles off. This will activate the microprocessor's battery saving feature.

Time Limits

20-Second Pitch Mechanic

- 1. When the pitcher receives the ball on the mound, the 20-second time limit starts.
- 2. Press rocker switch to "**o**" for timing the 20-second pitch.
- 3. The timer will give a short, 2 second buzz after 12 seconds have elapsed.
- 4. After 20 seconds have elapsed, the timer will buzz again for 5 seconds.
- 5. The time stops when the pitcher begins his pitching motion. Press the "Reset" button to reset the timer.

90-Second Between Innings Time Limit

- Between innings, teams have 90 seconds to be ready for the first pitch (pitcher holding the ball and touching the pitcher's plate) and a batter standing in the batter's box ready to hit.
- 2. The 90-second clock begins when all defensive players have started to leave their positions after the last out.
- Press rocker switch to "●" for timing the 90 second between innings time limit.
- At the 60-second vibration, visually cue the plate umpire, who will then signal to the pitcher and catcher, "30 seconds left," and summon the lead-off batter to the plate.
- The time stops when the umpire calls "Play" for the first pitch of the first batter of the next half-inning.
- 6. Press the reset button to reset the timer.
